All Year:	 Study hard and improve grades Establish good relationships with teachers and other influential adults, thinking ahead to who you might ask for letters of recommendation
October:	Take PSAT during SAT School Day Start your college search (<u>www.cappex.com</u>)
November:	 Start planning for financial needs for senior year and college Talk to your parents about college finances Search and apply to scholarships (www.fastweb.com and www.raise.me)
December:	 Get PSAT scores back Use the My College Quickstart program to get a personalized plan for test preparation (Quick Reference Sheet) Start studying for the SAT (Khan Academy)
January:	 Begin to develop relationships with teacher/other influential adults who may be good candidates for writing letters of rec Start attending mandatory SAT Prep Continue to search and apply to scholarships
April:	 Register for June SAT test Register for June ACT test Register for May SAT Subject Test (if recommended by your Program Director)

June:	Take SAT test Take Act test
