August:		August 1 <sup>st</sup> – UC Application Opens
September:		Register for October ACT (If you plan to retake and improve score) Make sure you have a financial plan to cover the potential orientation and housing costs you will need to pay in April (Up to \$1,000+) Begin writing Personal Insight Questions (PIQs)
		Finalize Academic Resume
October:		October 1 <sup>st</sup> – CSU Application Opens; FAFSA/CADAA Opens Begin working on college applications Take SAT during SAT School Day (All students are pre-registered) Take ACT (If you registered) Attend an application workshop hosted by CIR or school's College and Career Center Start CSU EOP Application (You will need respond to 5 questions) Contact teachers/other influential adults to be a recommender and/or complete EOP recommendation forms
November:		November 1 <sup>st</sup> -30 <sup>th</sup> – UC Application Submission Period November 30 <sup>th</sup> – CSU and UC Application Deadline Submit applications well in advance of deadline Submit EOP Applications ( <u>EOP deadlines</u> vary - apply as early as possible)
December:		Create your college portals and check them <b>weekly</b> (Respond to emails, requests for additional information, etc., promptly) Gather all documents needed for your FAFSA/CADAA (1040A, W-2, etc.)
January:	_	Submit FAFSA/CADAA (Submit early as possible) Start applying to scholarships Continue checking college portals
March:		March 2 <sup>nd</sup> – FAFSA/CA Dream Act application Due Start hearing back from colleges Continue to check college portals Continue to apply to scholarships

April:	Evaluate college acceptances

	Be prepared to pay deposits, orientation and housing fees when
	you accept a college acceptance offer
	Document on your calendar all fees and deadlines you will need
	to meet (If you miss any of the deadline, your admission offer may
	be rescinded)
	Continue to apply to scholarships
May:	May 1 <sup>st</sup> – College Decision Day (Deadline to commit to a college)
	Submit CIR Scholarship Application – Due in May
Summer:	Attend CIR Summer Melt Program
	Attend Summer Bridge classes if required by your college
